#### UNISON Raises SLT with Councillors

At our quarterly meeting with Councillors UNISON raised their obligation to fund leisure services during the pandemic, sharing the Local Government Association Guidance with them. Councillors stated they would fulfil their obligations and agreed with the trade unions that SLT should not be seeking to move away from NJC body that negotiates pay, terms and conditions. Since then the Council has commissioned Sport England to look at the situation. We are awaiting the results of this report. Meanwhile, in Peterborough, their leisure provider has handed the service back to Peterborough Council.
