## Car Parking Fees Deal 2025

The deal for Sandwell Council staff is for the full 5-day fee to be discounted to £330 for the year, whether based in West Brom or elsewhere. The discounted prices for 2-day passes are £132, 3-day passes are £198 and 4-day passes £264. There is also flexibility on being able to change days applicable from 1<sup>st</sup> May. To obtain these discounts staff must purchase their pass each month via MiPermit.

These discounted rates follow a petition submitted by UNISON to the Council. Sandwell Children's Trust still fails to apply these discounted rates.
